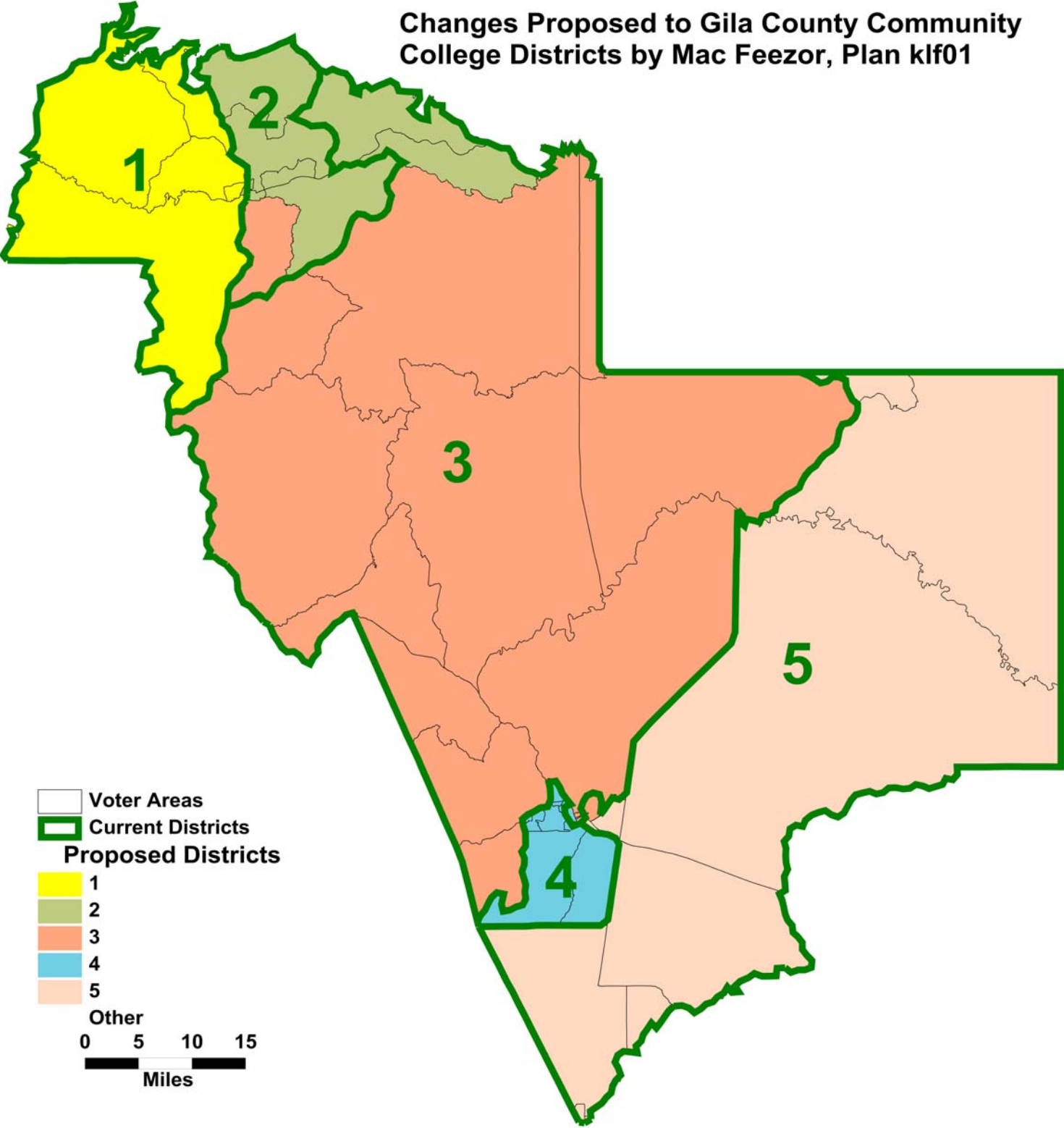

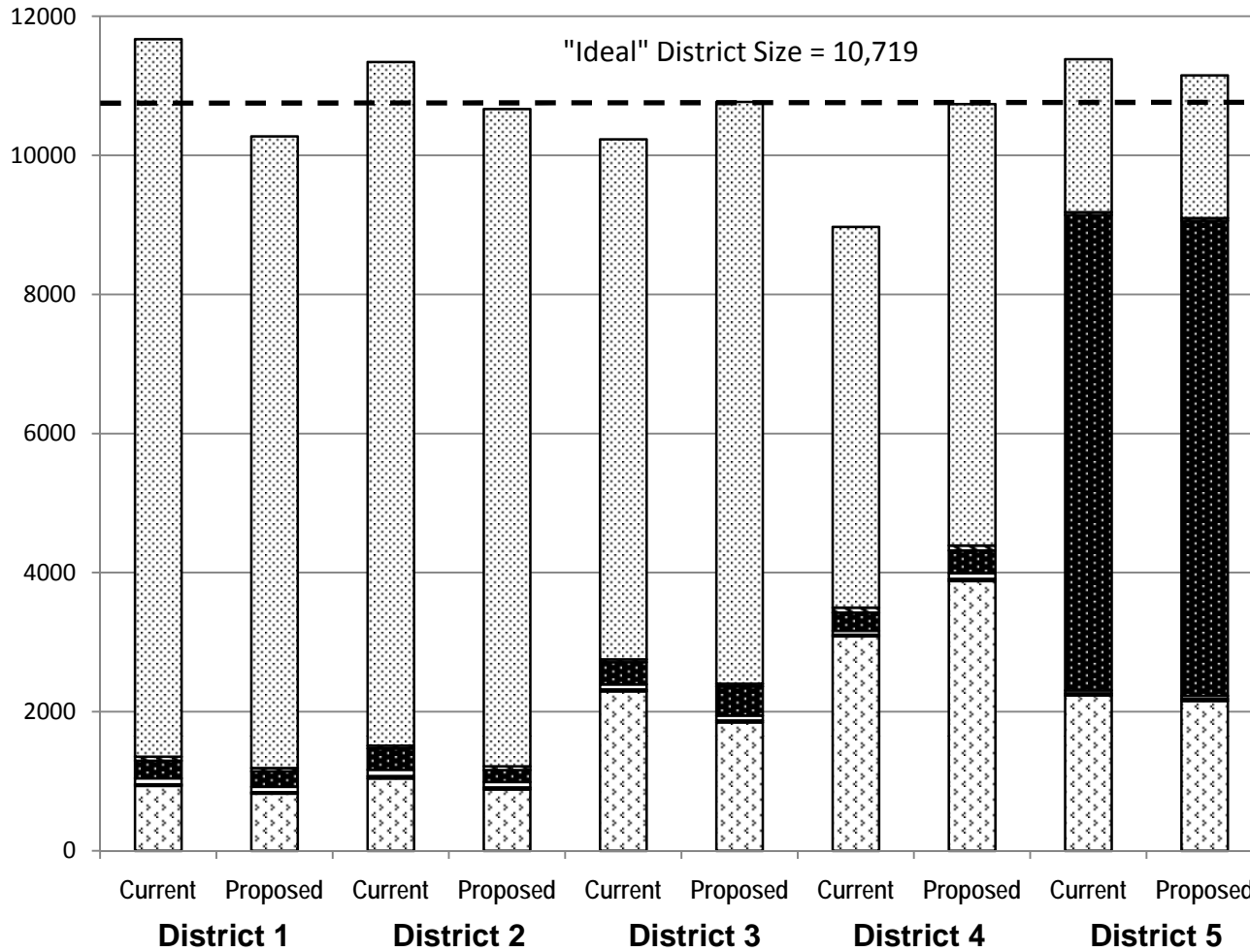

Consultant's review comments:

This plan reduces the overall population deviation from over 25 percent down to about 8 percent. The plan slightly increases the minority proportion in the two districts with the largest benchmark values, and decreases the proportion about 4 percentage points in District 3 down to about 19 percent voting-age minority.
