Star Valley plans to fix Moonlight, Pinon

Star Valley will spend \$240,000 in federal grant funds to make flood and safety improvements on a portion of Moonlight inprovements on a portion of Moonlight Drive and in upgrading Pinoa Drive. The council on Tuesday shuffled its priorities for spending of the federal money and tropped flood control improvements on quall Hollow Drive to the bottom of its priority list. The Community Block Grant Development funds are intended to help cities and towns help low-income residents. Payson generally spends its block grant money on things like rehabilitation of low-income housing and reducing neighborhood blight.

However, Town Manager Tim Orier asseured the council during its meeting that he town remains free to use the money on things like street improvements, since most of Star Valley qualifies as a lower-income area under the federal guidelines.

The council made a roughly \$100,000 project to improve a 4,000-fool-long stretch of Pinon Drive in the Diamond Point area its lop profully. The money would pay for puving, widening, and Improvements to remove the deep dilches on both sides of the curbles road.

Grier said that with the completion of those two projects, Star Vulley will have paved 90 percent of the dirt roads it inherited from Gila County when the town incorporated six years ago.

Several countel members wondered aloud whether it was a good iden to spend the federal low-income grant money on street repairs. Normally, the town uses gas tax Highway User Revenue Pund (HURF) many many the state to fund road improvements.

However, the state reduced HURF payments to cities and lowns by about 18 percent list year and is devoling a growing percentage of the gas tax money to providing money for the state Department of Public Safety.

Grier sald "HURF is decilaing and it looks like a continuing trend — the robbing of HURF money for cities and towns. (The Legislature) used to applogize as they pieked your pocket, but now they no longer do."

The council wrestled with setting the priorities, since Quail Hollow also suffers from croslo and flooding problems in heavy rains.

The council ultimately approved the priority list, but said the town should spend the several thousand dollars necessary to do a title search nlong the right-of-way.

"That's probably money well spent," said Cauncilor George Binney of the right-of-way little search.

The council also debated whether to remove Quall Hollow from the priority list and replace it with one final flood-prone crossing on Moonlight Drive.

However, Grier said the town hadn't done the necessary studies needed to get that Moonlight Drive crossing added to the upproved list of projects prior to the federal deadline for committing the funds.

Redistricting maps go to supervisors

Gila County's Redistricting Advisory Committee offielally accomplished its mission when it handed over
maps of voltag districts to the board of supervisors at
its meeting on aug. 13.

Now the job of narrowing the field and submitting
redistricting maps to the Department of Justikes for the
Gila County Board of Supervisors and Gila Community
College lies with the supervisors and the public.

"Our goal was to submit at least two maps of each
district, but we ended up with three," said Robert
Sanchez, chairman of the advisory committee.

"Coples of these maps have gone to the ribal councils, towns, and political parties. We want naps together by the presidential election in January of 2012," said
Linda Eastlick, director of Gila County elections.

Despite a diverse mix of members both ravially polit-

leally, and from different geographical areas in the county, the committee found the experience amicable, said member David Prechtel.

Vet the job wasn't casy, Out of 21 maps submitted for the supervisor districts, 20 did not meet the requirements of the Voling Rights Act. The maps for the community ordige district fell closely within guidelines, said Sanchez.

The committee worked hard with consultants analyzing submitted maps to find acceptable deviations of population and minority voting block numbers to pass DOJ requirements. The committee held 11 meetings from March 22 until July 29, traveling from San Carlos to Pine and Strawberry, reported Sanchez.

At the end of the committee's presentation, the board of supervisors thanked members and voted to dissolve the committee.



· Why do we redistrict? The US Constitution, under the principle of "one person, one vote" requires districts from which we elect representatives be substantially equal in total census population. Because the population changes with each census, jurisdictions must review new population statistics and determine the extent to which population must be

* The difference in "substantially equal" census population between districts should be less than 5% range. Previously the Department of Justice allowed variances up to 10%, however, recent court cases have reinforced lower percentages. strength of racial or language minority populations as they exist in the present districts.

 Federal law requires that the U.S. Department of Justice approve all redistricting plans in Arizona, and in many other states, before the plans can be used and elections can take place. If the Department of Justice decides that Gila County's redistricting plan is dis-criminatory, they will not allow Gila County to use the discriminatory redistricting plan. Sometimes a majority of minorities live in a given district. This is called "minority ma-jority". A statistical analysis using 2010 minority population Census numbers and past minority voting history will be performed on any plan submitted to ensure compliance with Voting District Act provincements.


