

Proposer's Comments:

This is a second effort at trying to arrange for fair representation for all citizens in Gila County while keeping the incumbents in their area of residence and keeping the Indians and Hispanics together.

Consultant's Review Comments:

The district population equality of this proposed plan is very close: a total plan deviation of just over one-half of one percent.

District 2's voting-age minority proportion increases eleven percentage points to 41.2 percent, but that gain is at the expense of District 3, which loses over ten percentage points. That loss in District 3 will be considered a significant retrogression of minority voting strength.
