

Consultant's Review Comments:

Each proposed district is very close to the ideal population; the total plan deviation is about 1 percent. Under this plan, District 2's minority proportion increases from 30 percent to almost 41 percent. However, that gain is at the expense of District 3, which gains Anglo residents and loses Hispanics. District 3's Native American proportion has a small decrease under this plan, but the most serious detriment is in the loss of over 12 percentage points in District 3's total minority proportion; a retrogression of minority voting strength that takes the district out of having a voting-age minority majority.
