

## **Consultant's Review Comments:**

This plan reduces the population deviation from 6.7 percent to less than two percent. The voting-age minority proportion in District 3 rises by almost nine percentage points, perhaps unnecessarily, given that it was already a minority-majority district.

The voting-age minority proportion in District 2 drops almost seven percentage points -- a change that will probably be considered retrogressive.
